NOCTURNO project - Non-Conventional Wave Propagation for Future Sensing and Actuating Technologies is funded through H2020-MSCA-RISE programme, and it focuses on development of sensors and actuators based on non-conventional propagation of acoustic waves in artificial media, electromagnetic/optical sensors based on metasurfaces, and advanced manufacturing technologies with the aim to provide practical solutions for the fabrication of novel acoustic and metasurface-based sensors and actuators.
